

Crochet Pattern by Hannah Daley US terminology



FINISHED SIZE:

6-7 in / 15-17 cm height 6-7 in / 15-17 cm width

Materials:

- ✓ worsted weight yarn
- ✓ size G (4mm) crochet hook
- ✓ yarn needle
- ✓ fiberfill

Abbreviations:

MR = Magic Ring ch = chainsl st = slip stitchsc = single crochet

Instructions:

EYE SPOT

With brown yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnd 1: (Inc)x6. (12) SI st in next sc. F/O.

HEAD

With white yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnd 1: (Inc)x6. (12) Rnd 2: (Sc, Inc)x6. (18) Rnd 3: (Sc 2, Inc)x6. (24) Rnd 4: (Sc 3, Inc)x6. (30) Rnd 5: (Sc 4, Inc)x6. (36) Rnd 6: (Sc 5, Inc)x6. (42) Rnd 7: (Sc 6, Inc)x6. (48) Rnds 8-13 (6 Rnds): Sc 48. (48) Rnd 14: (Dec, sc 6)x6. (42) Rnds 15-16: Sc 42. (42) Rnd 17: (Dec, sc 5)x6. (36) Rnds 18-19: Sc 36. (36) Rnd 20: (Dec, sc 4)x6. (30) Rnd 21: Sc 30. (30) Rnd 22: (Dec, sc 3)x6. (24) Rnd 23: Sc 24. (24) Place one safety eye through Eye Spot, then attach between Rnds 16 and 17. Attach other safety eye between Rnds 16 and Rnd 19: (Dec)x6. (6) 17. Add fiberfill. Continue adding fiberfill until piece is fastened off. Rnd 24: (Dec, sc 2)x6. (18) Rnd 25: (Dec, sc)x6. (12)

lnc = 2 sc in one stitchDec = sc2tog or invisible decreasests = stitchesF/O = Fasten Off

Rnd 26: (Dec)x6. (6) F/O, thread yarn through remaining sts.

BODY

With brown yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnd 1: (Inc)x6. (12) Rnd 2: (Sc, Inc)x6. (18) Rnd 3: (Sc 2, Inc)x6. (24) Rnd 4: (Sc 3, Inc)x6. (30) F/O brown yarn. Attach white yarn. Rnd 5: Sc 30. (30) Rnd 6: (Sc 4, Inc)x6. (36) Rnd 7: (Sc 5, Inc)x6. (42) Rnd 8: Sc 42. (42) Rnd 9: (Sc 6, Inc)x6. (48) Rnds 10-11: Sc 48. (48) Rnd 12: (Sc 6, Dec)x6. (42) Rnd 13: Sc 42. (42) Rnd 14: (Sc 5, Dec)x6. (36) Rnd 15: (Sc 4, Dec)x6. (30) Rnd 16: (Sc 3, Dec)x6. (24) Add fiberfill. Continue adding fiberfill until piece is fastened off. Rnd 17: (Sc 2, Dec)x6. (18) Rnd 18: (Sc, Dec)x6. (12) F/O, thread yarn through remaining sts.

LEGS

Make 4. With white yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnd 1: (Inc)x6. (12) Rnd 2: (Sc, Inc)x6. (18) Rnd 3: (Sc 2, Inc)x6. (24) Rnds 4-5: Sc 24. (24) Rnd 6: (Dec, sc 2)x6. (18) Rnds 7-8: Sc 18. (18) Rnd 9: (Dec, sc)x6. (12) Rnd 10: Sc 12. (12) Add fiberfill. Rnd 11: (Dec)x6. (6) F/O, leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

EARS

Make 2. Do not stuff ears. With white or brown yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnd 1: Sc 6. (6) Rnd 2: (Sc 2, Inc)x2. (8) Rnd 3: (Sc 3, Inc)x2. (10) Rnd 4: (Sc 4, Inc)x2. (10) Rnd 5: (Sc 5, Inc)x2. (12) Rnd 5: (Sc 5, Inc)x2. (14) Rnd 6: (Sc 6, Inc)x2. (14) Rnd 6: (Sc 6, Inc)x2. (16) Rnd 7: (Sc 7, Inc)x2. (18) Rnd 8: (Sc 8, Inc)x2. (20) Rnd 9: (Sc 9, Inc)x2. (22) Rnd 10: (Sc 10, Inc)x2. (24)



Rnds 11-16 (6 Rnds): Sc 24. (24) Ch 1, turn. Fold piece flat and working through both sides at once, sc 12 across. F/O, leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

NOSE

With black yarn, ch 5. Inc in 2nd ch from hook, sc in each of next 2 ch, Inc in last ch. Now working on opposite side of ch in the unworked back loops: Inc, sc 2, Inc. SI st in next sc. F/O, leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

TAIL

Do not stuff tail. With white or brown yarn, 6 sc into MR. Rnds 1-4 (4 Rnds): Sc 6. (6) F/O, leave a tail of yarn for sewing.

COLLAR (OPTIONAL)

You may need to adjust the number of chains needed, depending on the size of your finished dog. Ch 21. Sc in 2nd ch and in each remaining ch. F/O.

ASSEMBLY

Sew head to body. Sew ears to head. Fold ears halfway down and tack them in place with yarn needle and scrap of matching yarn. Sew nose to head.

Sew nose to nead.

Sew legs to body.

Sew tail to body.

Place collar around dog's neck and sew collar to itself, being careful not to twist it as you do so.
